Computer and Internet Rules:	

If you wish to see the complete Internet Usage Policy ask the Library Staff at the front desk. General Rules:

- You may use the computer for 1 hour if others are waiting to use the computer. If no one is waiting to the computer then you may use it for as long as need.
- Printing costs are posted by each computer
- Person under age 18 must have signed permission slip on file at the front desk

Internet Rules:

Library Staff have final authority over patron conduct. The following list of issues, but not limited to the list, are prohibited:

- Unauthorized access included hacking
- Piracy
- Obscene materials public display of pornography is illegal in North Dakota (NDCC 12.1-17.1)
- Cyberbullying
- Ford or beverage in the computer area
- Identity theft
- Listening to audio without headphones
- Installing software on library computers
- Any behaviors that impair the ability of other patrons to use the library.

Enforcement:

Patrons perceived to be in violation of this policy will receive:

- A verbal warning and asked to leave the computer area immediately
- A written warning with computer privilege denied for one (1) week
- Denied usage of computers permanently.

Parents are responsible for their child's behavior.

U.S. Patriot Act: This act allows the FBI access through search warrants to any and all information stored on the computers in the Griggs County Public Library. The FBI may remove any and all computers with approved search warrants, however the library will not be allowed to inform you or the public that such a search has been conducted.
